To whom it may concern,

In response to the inquiry performed in Q3 2010, the OWASP Board hereby suspends Christian Heinrich from holding any OWASP leadership position, including but not limited to OWASP projects, chapters, and committees for a period of six months effective immediately through March 8th, 2011. Christian must not act as or misrepresent himself as an OWASP Leader during this period. This decision is undertaken because of behavior unbecoming of an OWASP Leader and accusatory and inflammatory comments that are inconsistent with OWASP principles. We encourage and welcome positive participation by Christian in OWASP projects and chapters as a normal member of the OWASP community so long as that participation is consistent with our culture and principles of conduct. Specifically, all comments shall be civil and respectful - any contrary behavior will not be tolerated. Following the suspension period, the Board will re-evaluate Christian's status based on his behavior and participation.
